


Ivy Newport



I have always loved drawing as a child. I was born and grew up in south-east-Asia, often travelling. We were full-time volunteers, often on the move, and we made art with children all over the world. Orphanages, hospitals, rehab centers, whatever. I think that's one thing that in some way influenced my art later on. I wanted to create some place where children would feel safe. A beautiful world that would whisk them away from an often harsh and painful reality, even for just a little while.

In the years followed I moved to Italy and started a life of my own, and married and had a child. Too busy with just every-day life, my art was often pushed aside. I got to the point where I felt I had lost my true identity, and who I really was inside. And that's when I desperately needed to find myself and my artistic voice again. And so I started the slow and difficult process of rediscovery. I learned many things during that time, but most of all, I learned how to listen to my heart and my intuition. I had to let go of my fears and just trust the process. And it was a liberation! I painted of stories untold, of feelings repressed, of my hopes and dreams, and deepest yearnings. Of magic and mystery, and fairytales, and emotions and yearnings never expressed.



I took aside a small part of my busy day, every day, and I sat at my desk and I showed up. And it's a habit I've kept ever since. That was when I started to notice the difference. I realized that the more I painted for just me and the pure joy of it, and for expression, the more I began to paint what I felt inside and my art looked more like my own, and I was a much happier person! If we can just create for the pure joy of it, we open up a whole new world of expression in our art... And that is when the magic happens!

Stephen, a 31-year-old husband and father, found a love for drawing in Mrs. Gaylor's Kindergarten class in 1989. What began with simple drawings of Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles, evolved over years of practice and training into a wide range of artistic endeavors. He found painting, ceramics, and pastels in high school and quickly adopted them into his tool box of creativity. In college, he earned his B.A. in painting from UNC Charlotte and decided to go after his artistic dreams with the support of his loved ones. 
He is currently working towards a solo show in mid 2017, in the Duke Energy Tower, in uptown Charlotte. The wall space is so substantial that Barings, the global asset management firm hosting the show, has requested between 25 to 30 paintings to be displayed on the walls of 2 floors within the building. This show will function as a fundraiser for The Levine Children's Hospital. The connection to the children within the hospital, has a great deal of impact on the Stephen's work.

"All an artist does is create his or her own rules, follow them, and throw out everything else." - Stephen Lursen

The rules for his current work are as follows:

1. Create a richly colored abstract background
2. If adding an illustrative character, the character/s must either float or fly to emote a sense of weightlessness, unburdened by the cares of this life. Hope, peace, and joy are key words for each work. Stephen's hope is that each painting would inspire the imagination of children and adults into the fantasies of their mind.)
3. Splatter and throw paint at the surface with joy (there's more to each painting... normally... but these are his rules)

His involvement in Ever After 2017 is a perfect fit both stylistically and in content. He hopes you will both enjoy and learn from his instructional video, as you push deeper into your own imagination, and paint your fantasies. 
Tiare Smith is a self-taught mixed media, art journal artist and instructor.

EFFY WILD



However, I didn't fully immerse myself into a creative life until 2013 when my sister introduced me to some online courses.



Toni Burt





Flora lives with her boyfriend and spirit dog, Pearl, in a colorful community of fellow artists in Portland, Oregon.
