Mastering Mixed Media

Creating My Favorite Collage Papers for Mixed Media

SUPPLY LIST

This collage paper is easy and doesn't need unusual or hard to find items. Hopefully, you have all of them in your studio already! At the bottom, I have a small list of the items I'm using with affiliate links in case you want that particular supply.

- Medium: any acrylic medium will work I will be using Liquitex Matte Medium
- **Spreader**: A Brayer, Brush, or Silicone Shaper Tool (anything that spreads medium) I will be using a Speedball Brayer
- **Backing Collage Paper**: Tissue, Teabag Paper, Rice Paper or Medical Exam Paper I will be using medical exam paper but any kind of paper you use for collage will work

Collage Fodder: Receipts, Maps, Magazine Clippings, Asemic Writing, To Do Lists, Ephemera, anything with wording, or any collage you would like to include I will be using maps, to do lists, and various papers with wording

Used Palette Paper Loaded with Dry Paint: you can use paper palettes, silicone mats, anything you can lift dried paint from--but the dried paint is crucial

I will be using both paper palettes and silicone mats

Drying Station: Just a flat place to leave palettes drying will do, but if you want to speed things up, you can add a blow dryer on 'low' or 'cool' setting (more info about my set up in the class video)
