Suggested Art Supplies for our lesson:

Please know you don't need to buy all the supplies I listed. You might already have many of them, so use the ones you have on hand that are your favorite. Stick with the colors you love. With art journaling, you can use anything!

Art Journal:

Any art journal is fine if the paper is thick enough for paints and glue! I love the Ranger Dylusions art journals as they are solid and you can add a ton of stuff, plus there's an envelope in the back:)

You can do this lesson on watercolor paper or a clay board as well, which is always fun!

These are the 2 journal sizes I love and use a lot:

Collage Materials:

Before class, have fun collecting papers you can collage with and sketch on!

Vintage book pages, music sheets, deli or rice paper, handwritten notes, patterned papers, or even scraps from old letters. Art scraps are great too!

Brushes:

A yucky one for gluing

A round one to use with water over Tombow markers - any size will do.

Pens + Markers

Paint Pens - just a couple of colors you might like to use for small details. I love Posca pens.

Signo White Gel Pen

Micron Black Pen or any archival pen

Indenti-pen or Sharpie

Tombow Markers - just a couple needed in your favorite colors

Misc:

Matte Medium or Mod Podge or glue stick

Scissors

Plus, really anything you can think of can go in your art journal:)
