



## **MATERIALS for Sanctuary Play - Loose Botanicals**

*A Gentle Mixed Media Botanical with Denise Daffara*

*These are the supplies I used... please be free to use what you have, and love*

**Watercolour paper:** CANSON XL Textured: Mixed Media, A3 cut in half... 300gsm/140lb ... any water colour or mixed media paper will be fine.

**Black Fine Waterproof Pen :** uni-ball eye micro (my favourite.. available at officeworks in Aus) just check yours in 'permanent' or 'water proof'.

**Neo color II :** light olive, gold, moss green, chromium oxide green

**Watercolour pencils:** FABER CASTELL, earth green, moss green, beech green DERWENT Inktense, deep indigo (for the small bottles in front)

**Ink:** SENNELIER Indigo blue \* this one loosens when wet, if you prefer that not to happen... I'd recommend Daler Rowney ink. indigo or prussian blue

**Watercolour tray :** PAUL RUBENS set of 26... but I used a mix of greens, dash of yellow... tiny bit of pink and white... and mixed and played with the colours on the palette.. Remembering this is a playful activity... any water colour paints will be fine... or fluid acrylics... inks... it's about the watery quality to give you some transparency... and looseness

**Brushes:** a no 2 liner brush is good for when you want to have fine painted lines a round brush.. and flat... small to medium for tiny areas like leaves.. but feel free to use a larger flat brush for larger areas... and especially the 'wash' for the table top area.
